Course: AP ART 3D DESIGN

Prerequisites:

Ceramics 2 (3D media focus, level 2)
or permission of the instructor via portfolio review.

Short Course Description:

Intensive studio work to develop a college level portfolio demonstrating quality, breadth, and concentration in 3D design work. Design involves purposeful decision making about using the elements and principles of art in an integrative way. In the 3-D Design Portfolio, you should demonstrate your understanding of design principles as they relate to depth and space. These issues can be explored through additive, subtractive, and/or fabrication processes.

Summer Assignment:

Work Load during the School Year:

The 3D Design Portfolio MUST include 20 to 25 3-dimensional artworks. A production level equal to this demand is necessary.

Special Course Information:

Students will be required to take slides of their work for presentation in the portfolio. Slide film and developing is the student's responsibility.
