THE SCHOOL & COMMUNITY

Located just four miles from Washington, DC, the McLean community is home to a highly educated business and professional population that demands excellence in education. The quality of our students' educational experiences is a direct reflection of our community's commitment to its schools. McLean offers an academically challenging program with courses designed to complement the broad interests and abilities of a culturally diverse student body. Because of the strong academic orientation of the McLean community, the curriculum focuses on college preparation with an impressive array of advanced placement courses while offering a wide variety of electives designed to appeal to all interests and vocations. In recognition of the academic successes of its students, in 2008-2009 McLean was ranked #55 in the nation by US News and World Report and #115 in the nation by Newsweek magazine. McLean is fully accredited by the Commonwealth of Virginia and the Southern Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, and a recipient of the Virginia Index of Performance Excellence Award. Our enrollment for grades 9-12 is 1,855 with 443 seniors, 449 juniors, 455 sophomores, and 508 freshmen. Of our 2009 graduates, 77 percent attended four year colleges and 16 percent attended two year colleges. McLean has eight National Merit Semifinalists and 37 Commended students in the class of 2010.
