As an integral part of this effort, the counselor extends a hand to ALL children. The counseling program supports and complements the efforts of the classroom teacher to facilitate your child's learning.

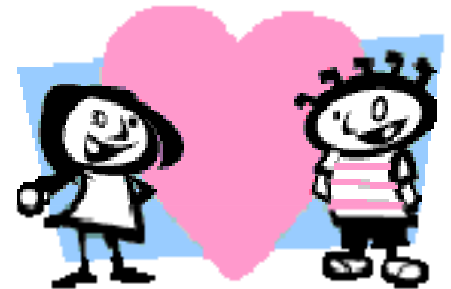
