Important Immunization Information for Rising Sixth Graders (SY 2009-2010)

Before starting Sixth Grade, all students must receive a booster dose of the Tdap vaccine if at least five years have passed since the last dose of tetanus-containing toxoid.

A medical exemption is also acceptable.

The Tdap booster is available from your physician., or from The Fairfax County Health Department which provides school immunizations at no cost.
