YOU CAN HELP KEEP OUR STAFF AND STUDENTS HEALTHY

Please keep your student home when he/she has:

- A fever of 100 degrees or higher. The student should stay home until he/she is fever free, without medication, for 24 hours.
- A persistent, productive cough or wheezing coupled with a thick or constant nasal discharge.
- Vomiting or diarrhea during the previous night
- Pink eye with white or yellow discharge or if matted eyelids after sleep, eye pain and redness is present.
- Strep throat/scarlet fever
- An undiagnosed rash

If a student is sick, keeping them at home will not only prevent the spread of communicable diseases but also enable a quicker recovery from the illness.
