



TITLE I SCHOOL

The Step Up Language Arts (SULA) program is designed to strengthen the reading and writing skills of students in grades 1-4. Students who need additional help are referred for the program by their classroom teacher. Identified students receive additional instruction by the Title I reading specialist.

Title I reading specialists and classroom teachers work together to assess students' strengths and needs and to plan appropriate literacy instruction. SULA instruction focuses on the five essential components of reading: phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension. SULA teachers work in classrooms as well as with small groups of students. They also provide ongoing professional learning for teachers in their schools. Instruction is based on the FCPS Program of Studies (POS) and the Virginia Standards of Learning (SOL).

The Step Up Mathematics (SUM) program is designed to increase the mathematics achievement of selected students in grades 4-6 in Title I schools. Students who need extra help are referred for the program by their classroom teacher. Identified students receive additional instruction by the Title I math specialist.

The SUM teacher works with the classroom teachers to assess students' strengths and needs and to plan appropriate mathematics instruction. Instruction is focused on helping students develop mathematics concepts, problem solving strategies, and computational skills. SUM teachers work in classrooms as well as with small groups of students. They also provide ongoing professional learning for teachers in their schools. Instruction is based upon the FCPS Program of Studies (POS), the Virginia Standards of Learning (SOL), and the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics (NCTM) Standards.
