## Road Map to Academic Success

Key Questions for Parents addressed in the Road Map:

K-12

- What courses do parents want for their child/ren to have taken by 12<sup>th</sup> grade so that they may meet expected educational opportunities?
- What educational opportunities do parents expect for their child/ren beyond high school
- Are Honors and Advanced Placement courses open to all students?
- What percentage of student should be enrolled in Honors and Advanced Placement courses?
- What are the requirements needed to graduate from high school?
- What are the various types of diplomas and the requirements for each?
- At what grade levels are key decisions made? When do parents need to make specific decisions for their child/ren?
- What do parents need to do to ensure their expectations are met?
- When should parents begin talking with school staff to plan the academic road map for their child/ren?
- What is the parent's role in course selection?
- What are the homework expectations for each grade level?
- How do parent involve their child/ren in this process
