The data in this report were collected as part of the Virginia Student Record Collection which is required by the Virginia Department of Education. This Student Mobility Report provides information to support management of Fairfax County Public Schools.

DEFINITION

Student mobility is a measure of change in student membership from the first official membership count (September 8, 2008) through the last day of the school year. In 2008-2009, the modified elementary and secondary schools reflect a change in membership from the fifth day after their start date (August 1, 2008, for elementary schools and August 22, 2008, for secondary schools), rather than September 8, 2008. The mobility rate is expressed as the percent of a school's enrollment entering or reentering after September 8, 2008, (or the fifth day) or leaving school prior to the last day of the school year. Specific categories of mobility include the following membership codes:

Entries

- E1 Students who have not previously, during the current school year, entered any public school within the United States.
- E2 Students who have entered a public school in another state, but have not entered a public school in Virginia in the current school year.
- R3 Students received from a public school in Virginia, but outside Fairfax County.

Intra-county Transfers and Reentries

- R2 Students who transferred from one school to another school within Fairfax County.
- R4 Students reentering the same school after withdrawal during the current school year.

Withdrawals

- W Students who leave a Fairfax County public school regardless of reason.

County enrollments do not equal the sum of individual school's enrollments because of intra-county transfers. Students may be counted in enrollment in more than one school. Students are counted only once in county totals. Enrollment and mobility in special education and alternative education centers were excluded from the data in this report.

SUMMARY

- The county mobility rate for 2008-09 was 14.59 percent.
- Mobility rates were highest at the elementary level (16.64 percent) and lowest at the middle level (11.77 percent). (Table I, p. 3)
- In the past ten years, the mobility rate for the county was the highest, 16.13, in 2005-06 and the lowest, 14.59, in 2008-09. (Table II, p. 4).
- Mobility rates for ethnic groups ranged from 8.01 percent to 24.44 percent, excluding Hawaiian Native enrollment of 177 students. (Table VII, p. 8)

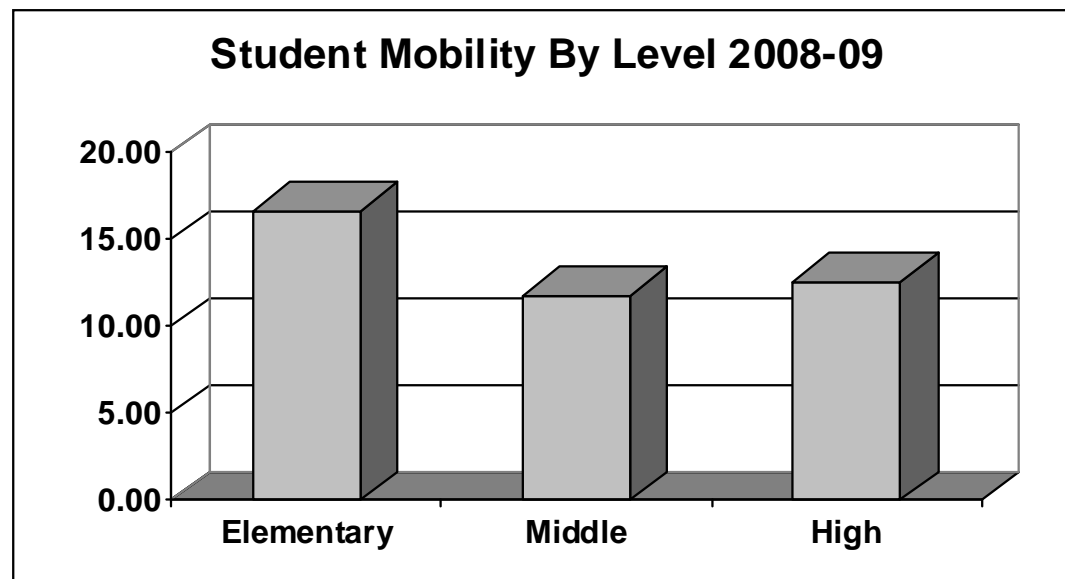

STUDENT MOBILITY RATES BY SCHOOL

Mobility rates at the elementary school level ranged from a low of 4.52 percent to a high of 40.23 percent. The median mobility rate for elementary schools was 15.04 percent. Middle school mobility rates ranged from 4.34 percent to 21.22 percent. The median mobility rate for middle schools was 9.96 percent. Mobility rates at the high school level ranged from 1.38 percent to 23.91 percent. The median mobility rate for high schools was 11.24 percent.

Tables III, IV, and V show the mobility rate and rank order for elementary, middle, and high schools, respectively.

STUDENT MOBILITY RATES BY REASON AND LEVEL

Students entering Fairfax County Public Schools after the fifth school day constituted 34.49 percent of all mobility. Of those students entering after the fifth day, students who transferred from schools within Virginia were 5.96 percent of mobility, and students who transferred from schools outside of the state were 7.61 percent. Students who had not previously enrolled in public school within the United States were 20.91 percent of mobility (see Appendix C).

Students transferring between county schools were 14.42 percent of all mobility. Students reentering the same Fairfax county school after withdrawal were 5.06 percent of mobility. The total of all student withdrawals from Fairfax County Public Schools is 46.03 percent of mobility. However, those student withdrawals without subsequent reentry into any Fairfax County school were 26.55 percent of mobility.

Table VI shows the percent of mobility by reason and level.

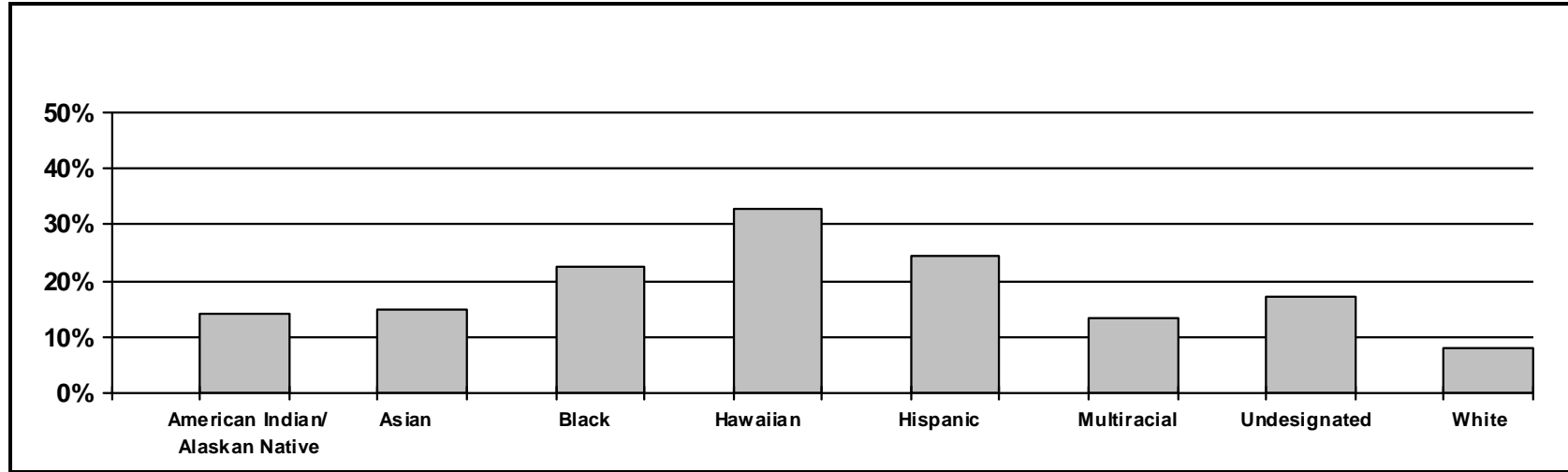
