

# Robinson 8<sup>th</sup> Grade General Supply List

Welcome to Robinson! Here are the basic supplies our MS students will need to start the school year. All of the core classes are included in this list. Classroom teachers will direct the students as to how to manage these materials after the supplies have been brought to school. However, please note that **individual teachers may require additional supplies** for their specific classroom needs. This information will be given out to students during the first days of school.

**Do NOT purchase an assignment notebook or agenda as one will be issued to each student at the beginning of the school year.**

- (1 ) Box of Tissues to be donated for school use
- (1) Pump container of gel hand sanitizer to be donated
- (1) Pencil Pouch: in the pouch, the student will need:
  - Large supply of wooden #2 pencils
  - Set of colored pencils
  - Several Colored pens (blue, black, red and green)
  - Assorted highlighters in at least 3 different colors, including yellow and blue
  - Eraser
  - Small pencil sharpener
  - (2) glue sticks
  - Metric ruler (Science)
- (1) Mead 5 Star, 5 Subject **college ruled** spiral notebooks (8 ½ x 11" pages) w/ vinyl cover (Civics)
- (1) 3 Subject **college ruled** spiral notebook (8 ½" x 11") (Science)
- (1) Single Subject **college ruled** spiral notebook (8 ½" x 11") (PE)
- (1) Combination Lock (PE Locker)
- (2) Packs of Loose leaf, college-ruled notebook paper
- Student's last name N-Z: (1) pair of fiskar scissors to be donated to Civics
- Student's last name A-M: (1) pack of 8 colored pencils to be donated to Civics
- (15) rolls of scotch tape to be donated—refills preferred (Math, Sci, and Civics)
- (1) Two pocket folder with metal brads (report folder) (PE)
- (1) Pack of 3x5 index cards
- (1) Pack of Post-it notes (any size)
- **Calculator Info:** Math 8 students will need access to a basic calculator at home

## Special Course Requirements

### ALGEBRA I AND ALGEBRA I HONORS:

- Calculator Info: Students will need a graphing calculator for Algebra I. Students may purchase their own or borrow a calculator from the school. Information about borrowing calculators will be distributed in the fall. If you purchase a graphing calculator, we recommend a TI-84 or TI-84+ (Texas Instruments).
