Submitting Digital Photos: Save photos at resolution of 300 dpi. Files must be in .tiff or .jpeg formats. The name of the file should be the student's first initial and last name. (John Smith = jsmith.jpg). Save the photos to a CD and submit with your order form and check. You can also e-mail the photos to sentryyearbook@gmail.com with your student's name in the subject line.

Submitting Conventional Photos: Submit hardcopy photos printed by a commercial photo printer (i.e., Walmart, Costco). **Do not print from your home computer and inkjet or laser printer, cut the photo into weird shapes or crop the photo in any way.** Please put the photo in an envelope marked with the student's name.

Message: Write your message legibly on the back of this form or attach a typed paper. Copyrighted material, such as song lyrics or poems, is not allowed and will be rejected. Be sure you include the appropriate signature (i.e. "Love, Mom and Dad" or "Friends forever, Sparkie") See the samples below:
