Program Title: Noncategorical Elementary Services

Noncategorical Elementary services (NCE) focus on the development of academic, communication, social/emotional, and life skills in a language-based environment. NCE services provide an instructional option for students, five years of age and older, who have one or more primary areas of disability and generally require intensive special education services for a majority of the day. Staff members emphasize collaboration with general education teachers at the students' grade levels, as well as intensive small group or individual instruction based on student needs.

Program Title: Elementary ID Program

The elementary program for students with intellectual disabilities (ID) is designed to support students in realizing their academic potential, accessing the general education curriculum, improving their social adjustment, and increasing appropriate behaviors. The purpose is to increase each student's performance in school, at home, and in the community, and to maximize the student's potential for productive employment and independent living.

Program Title: Learning Disabilities

The Learning Disabilities Program services students who are found eligible for educational support using federal, state and local guidelines. We service students with learning challenges in grade 1-6. We provide instruction using a flexible grouping and inclusive model in language arts and math. Our goal is to help all students be successful and develop independent learning skills within their classrooms.

Program Title: Speech and Language

Speech and Language is a Special Education program designed to provide services for students grade Kindergarten through 6th grade who exhibit an articulation, language, voice, fluency and/ or pragmatic disorder. Students must be evaluated and meet the requirements necessary to receive these services. Once a student is found eligible they are provided with a continuum of services from pull out services to monitoring within the classroom. Speech and Language screening is administered to all Kindergarten students as well as all new students to Fairfax County Public Schools in grades 1, 2 and 3.
