Homeroom/General Supplies

- 1 **Large** box of Tissues
- Disinfecting wipes
- 1 separate **Red** plastic pocket folder to be used as a take home folder.
- zipper pouch to hold pencils (soft not hard)
- 2 packages of pencils (sharpen at home) NO MECHANICAL PENCILS
- 1 small pencil sharpener
- eraser
- pens (erasable is recommended -blue or black) NO GEL PENS
- 2 felt-tipped pens for making corrections (non-erasable)
- 1 ream of white paper
- 1 memory stick (flash drive)
- 2 large glue sticks
- fine-tipped colored markers
- colored pencils

- package of small index cards
- light-colored highlighters
- ziploc bags-- Last Names beginning with A-M sandwich sized N-Z Gallon sized
