- 1 Package thin dry erase markers multi-color (boys only, community use)
- 1 Package thick dry erase markers multi-color (girls only, community use)
- 1 Box of quart-sized zip-top bags (boys only)
- 1 Container of Sanitizing Wipes (girls only)
- 1 Ream of white copy paper (girls only)
- 1 Ream of colored copy paper (boys only)
- 1 Package thin markers - 8 count (community use)
- 1 Package colored pencils - 24 count (community use)
- 1 Box of tissues (community use)
- 2 Boxes #2 pencils (Ticonderoga if possible, pre-sharpened is preferred, community use)
- 2 White magic rub erasers (community use)
- 1 Pair scissors – sharp (community use)
- 2 Yellow highlighters – thin (community use)
- 2 Packages wide-ruled filler paper (200 sheets) (community use)
- 8 Glue sticks - .70 oz. (community use)
- 1 Bottle Elmer's liquid school glue (community use)
- 1 12-inch ruler with standard and metric measurement (community use)
- 1 Small protractor (3 – 4 inches in length)
- 6 Marble composition notebooks
- 10 manila file folders
- 1 2-2 1/2 inch Binder with clear view pocket on outside and two interior pockets
- 1 3-hole Punch that will fit in a binder
- 1 Bag of five 3-hole binder dividers
- 6 Durable 2-pocket folders (must hold an 8.5" x 11" piece of paper and have three holes to fit into binder)
- 1 Flash Drive for saving documents
