

Show What You Know Expo – 2010

Rules and Guidelines for Students in Grades K-6

- 1) Entry Forms** must be submitted to classroom teachers or to the school office no later than **Monday, February 8, 2010**. Students may use an idea from the list, or submit an original idea.
- 2) Let the kids shine!** Parents may serve as advisors to their children, but the students should complete the majority of the work independently. (Remember, a 2nd grade board should look like a 2nd grade board.) ☺
- 3) All projects must be presented on a **3-panel presentation board**.** Science projects must follow the Scientific Method. Projects involving models should also have a presentation board explaining the process and theory behind the work.
- 4) If they choose, children may work with one partner who is in the same grade. The name of the partner should be included on the Entry Form. **Every participating child must submit a form with a parent's signature, even if there is a partner. (No form, no cool wristband).****
- 5) It is recommended that visuals be included on the presentation board.**
- 6) All projects and project boards should be brought to the school lobby between 8:45 – 9:30am on Thursday, March 11. (SACC parents may bring them to the office earlier). Please do not have your child bring in the board/project prior to the date, or have your child attempt to store the board in his/her classroom.**
- 7) The event will be held in the school cafeteria, gym and music room on the evening of Thursday, March 11, 2010 – from 6:30 – 7:30 pm**
- 8) Participants will be given an “explore time” to check out other student projects.**
- 9) It takes a lot of hands to make this event work, so please consider offering your time in one of the ways suggested on the entry form.**
