Sports and Recreation: The intramural program at MTMS offers students a variety of competitive opportunities. Students are exposed to team sport activities such as flag-football, soccer and basketball. We have a revolving sports schedule throughout the year, and use outdoor space when weather permits. Students MUST wear their Health & Physical education uniform in order to participate in ASP

activities. We also offer a weight room for students who would like to participate in solo workouts.

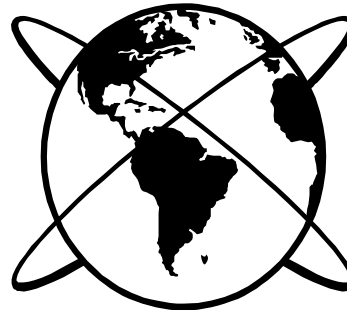
Open Computer Lab: Students are given time to continue to work on any school items but can also play appropriate games if they choose to. Lab will be open on Wednesdays.
