- ✓ There are two program levels:
 - Level One – Rising First, Second, and Third Grade Students
 - Level Two – Rising Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Grade Students
- ✓ To participate, students must get a Virginia Run R.E.A.D.S. Form that will be used to track books read over the summer. Forms are available on line at <http://www.fcps.edu/VirginiaRunES/>
- ✓ Students must read a minimum of five books to participate and are encouraged to read both fiction and non-fiction books
- ✓ Students will be recognized at a “Surprise Event” in September
- ✓ Prize tickets will be awarded for every additional five books read
- ✓ There will be a Grand Prize drawing of tickets and one student from each level win a prize
- ✓ Forms will be due back in September (date will be provided after school starts)
