Things that arise during registration

As parents are completing the online registration process, they may encounter some issues. We have come up with a few scenarios for parents in the event it happens to them.

What If.....

When the parent is completing the online registration, their printer malfunctions such as runs out of ink or is broken?

After completing the registration process, the parent is sent an email with a unique key that is used to complete the validation at the school. If they are unable to print where they initially registered, parents can print the unique key from another location or even write it on paper.

3 Important Information:

In order to complete your registration process, please print this page and take it, along with picture identification, to one of your children's school.

The school administrative staff will help you complete the registration process and activate your account.

A copy of this information has been sent to the email address you provided during registration.

Your unique key for this registration is **BC1C-86BC-BB14-6DC7**.

This unique key will expire in **20 days**.

PLEASE NOTE: You must complete the registration process at the school within the number of calendar days specified. Your unique key will expire at that time and you will be required to re-register for an account

If the parent arrives where the school the child that they registered attends and realizes that they don't have the unique key, the person validating the registration will be able to look-up the unique key. For example, you could not go to Woodson High School and ask that they look-up your child who attends Canterbury Woods School.
