**Overall Analysis (x 3: Thought Experiments; Periodization; Final Question)**

A great deal of analysis is evident, student attempts to use the book as evidence, to make connections with what she/he has already learned. Demonstrates critical thinking	10 points

Attempts analysis, but little to no evidence is used, and the student does not explicitly demonstrate analysis (answer <i>how, why</i> )	6 points
The responses summarize the reading rather than attempts analysis	4 points

**CCOT (Impacts of the Development of Agriculture Paragraphs)**

Responses contain both changes and continuities, clearly using multiple pieces of evidence from the reading	10 points
Responses contain either a change OR a continuity. There is some evidence from the reading.	8 points
Responses do not address change or continuity. May simply be a list of events with little to no discussion of the process of change/continuity over time.	6 points
