

# STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES ON AP EXAM DAY

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- **TWO** or more **sharpened** #2 pencils *[sharpen them at home!]*
- **ONE HIGHLIGHTER**
- **TWO** or more black or dark blue **ballpoint** [not felt-tip] pens  
**YOU WILL NEED PENS FOR ALL TESTS**
- A **watch** to help time yourself [you may not be able to see a clock]
- Your social security # and Photo ID
- A calculator for the Calculus, Statistics, Chemistry and Physics tests. Physics students may also bring a straightedge.
  
- **DO NOT BRING**  
Food or drinks to your desk, scratch paper, iPods, cell phones, reading material, etc.  
Leave your backpack in your locker. Each exam has a scheduled 10-minute rest break for bathroom or a drink, but *you may not go into your backpack during the break.*
- **YOU MAY BRING A BAG LUNCH IF YOU HAVE A SECOND EXAM ON THE SAME DAY.** If you do not have a second exam, you may leave a snack by the door [as you enter the exam] to eat at the break.

**Students must arrive to exams ON TIME. Students will not be permitted to enter the exam room once testing has begun.**

**Morning exams** – Arrive at 7:15 a.m.

**Afternoon exams** – Arrive at 11:30 p.m. Afternoon exams may end as late as 4:00 – Students need to arrange for their own transportation home.

**Students must remain in the exam room for the full time allowed for every test. No one leaves early.**

**DRESS IN LAYERS** –You may be COLD sitting in shorts for 3+ hours. On the other hand, it might be WARM. Dress in layers.

Any student having ‘*serious injury, illness or family tragedy*’ on exam day must notify the test coordinator at [Casey.Sarafinas@fcps.edu](mailto:Casey.Sarafinas@fcps.edu) 703-488-3842 before that day’s exam administration that they wish to be considered for a make-up exam. A doctor’s note is ***required*** for any illness.
