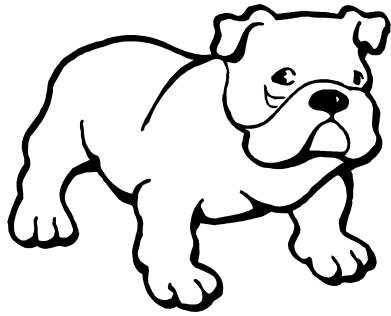

Create a positive, disciplined atmosphere for learning.
