Program requirements:

1. This preschool program is for children of income eligible families (refer to back page or the website for guidelines).
2. Children must be 3 years old by September 30th or 4 years old to be considered for the program. **Priority for placement in the program will be given to children who are 4 years old by September 30th.**
3. Families must live in Fairfax County.

How to apply:

2. Call the number below if you think you are eligible.
3. A staff member will verify your eligibility and send you a letter with an appointment time and an application site to visit.
