Directions to Johnson Center

From Route 495 (Capital Beltway)

Take exit 54A, Braddock Road West. Continue on Braddock Road for approximately 6 miles. Pass the first entrance to the university and turn right at light onto Roanoke River Road. Take next left into Parking Lot K or proceed to parking lot J. Follow signs to Johnson Center.

From Route 66 West (from Arlington, Washington, DC)

Take exit 60 at Route 123 South, Chain Bridge Road. Follow Rte. 123 through Fairfax City, turn left at University Drive. Take first right at Occoquan River Lane. Turn right onto Patriot Circle. Pass Physical Education Building; turn right into Parking Lot K or proceed to Parking lot J. Follow signs to Johnson Center.

From Route 66 East (from Front Royal)

Take Fairfax County Parkway exit (Rte. 7100) South. Exit at Braddock Road, take left fork, and turn left onto Braddock Road. Take first left past Route 123 onto Roanoke River Road. Take next left into Parking Lot K or proceed to parking lot J. Follow signs to Johnson Center.

From Route 95 (from points south)

Take exit 160B – Lake Ridge/Occoquan, Route 123 North (stay in the far right lane). Follow Route 123 for approximately 15 miles to Braddock Road, turn right onto Braddock Road. At 1st light, turn left on Roanoke River Road. Take next left into Parking Lot K or proceed to parking lot J). Follow signs to Johnson Center.
