# Speech-Language Pathology

Speech-Language Pathologists in Fairfax County Public Schools provide educationally relevant services to ensure students develop the communication skills needed to access the curriculum. SLPs work with preschool through high school students targeting disorders that include articulation, voice, fluency, receptive/expressive language, pragmatic language, apraxia, and dysphagia. Students with many disabilities including autism, learning disabilities, hearing impairment, moderate/severe disabilities, and physical disabilities benefit from the expertise and knowledge of speech-language pathologists. A continuum of service delivery provides students with the opportunity to use successful communication skills in a variety of settings.

## Fairfax County Public Schools

Located within the Washington DC metropolitan area, Fairfax County Public Schools is the 13th largest district in the nation. Currently 230 speech-language pathologists serve 11,000 students with communication disorders.
