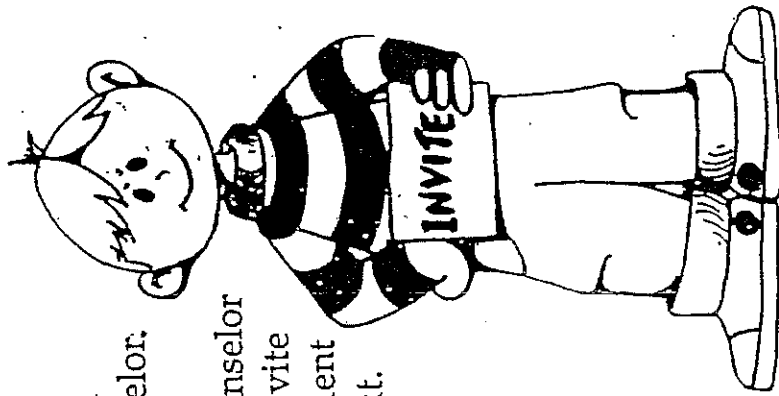


IT'S EASY TO TALK WITH MRS. HEMMIG AND MRS. KESSLER

School Counselors extend help to ALL children, not just the problem or troubled child. The counseling program supports and complements the efforts of the classroom teacher to facilitate your child's learning.

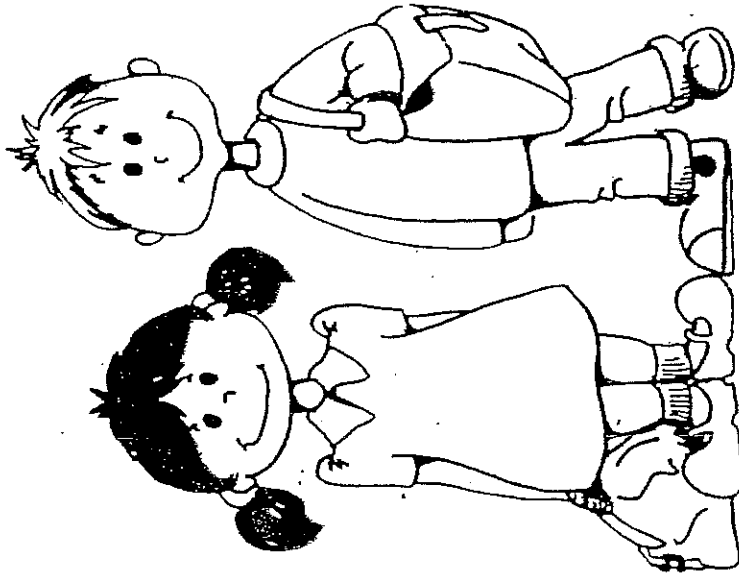

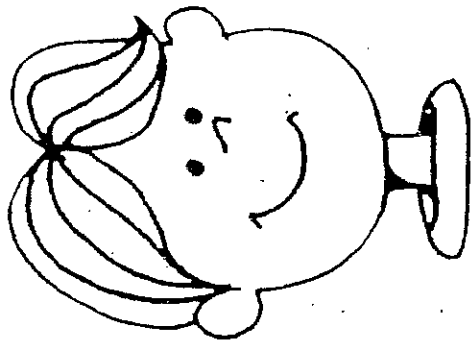

THE SCHOOL COUNSELORS At EAGLE VIEW SCHOOL

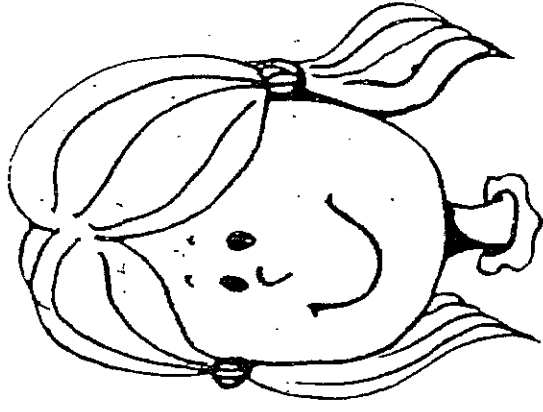
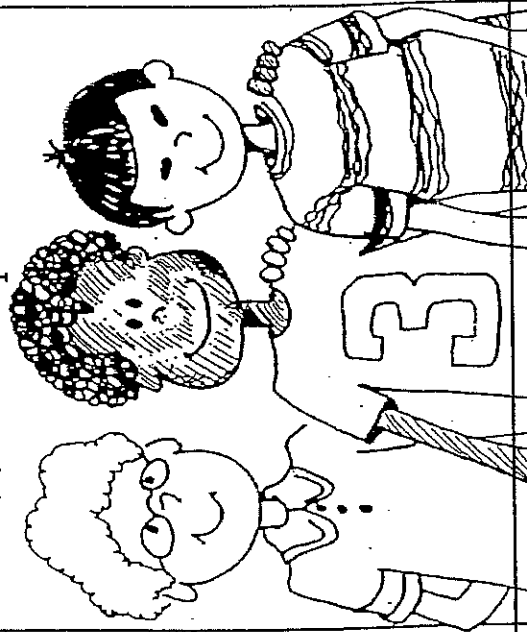




The counselor understands the process of growing up and the normal developmental problems students face.
