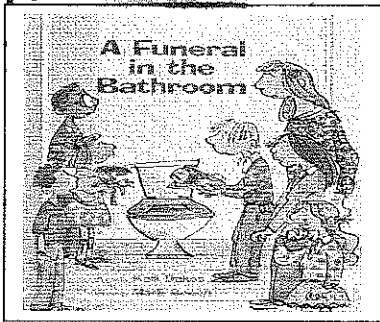

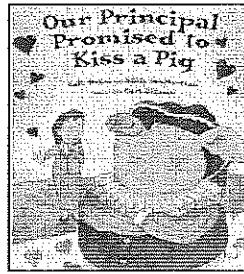

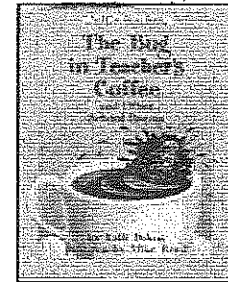
Our Principal Promised to Kiss a Pig

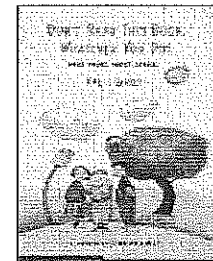

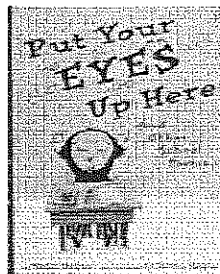

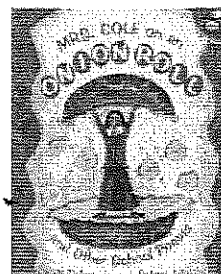
