## McDonald's Nights

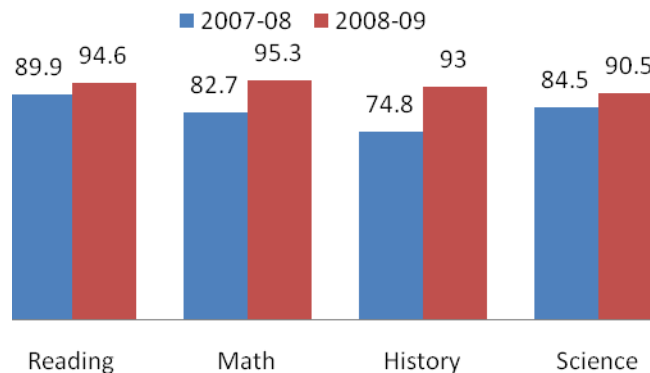

The Naglieri Nonverbal Abilities test will be given to all second graders on Sept. 23 at 9:30. Selected gr. 3-6 students who do not have a previous FCPS abilities test score will be tested that afternoon, 2-2:30 or 2:45-3:15.

Parents may request that a student in grades 3-6 retake either the Naglieri or Cognitive Abilities Test *once* during the student's elementary and middle school years. For a retest, send a letter or e-mail to Kimberly Willison, Test Coordinator, by Fri., Sept. 18.
