A message from our Principal

Dear Eagle View Families,

All schools create an annual School Improvement Plan. Although we were delighted with Eagle View's soaring success last year, we want to continually improve. Here's our plan and ways you can be involved.

This year Eagle View staff will focus on customizing instruction to meet your child's needs, particularly in reading and math. Grade level teams have already begun developing quizzes and assessments to tell us what your child already knows, and what your child needs to learn. Teachers will use that information to design lessons and activities. Both challenge and support will be important components of your child's work this year.

The Eagle View Way: respect for self, others, and surroundings (S.O.S.) will apply to

behavior in hallways, at arrival, and dismissal. Riders of buses who have earned the most points each week are invited to stand and "Bus-ta-Move" to music on the morning news show. Have you heard about it? Such fun! All classes will also participate in a service learning project sometime during the school year to show respect for "others" and "surroundings." You'll hear more about this later in the year.

We plan to offer parents a variety of ways to become informed about school programs and ways you can help your child. You're invited to join us for coffee and information on your way to work (and perhaps delay a stressful commute too!)

On Tuesday, October 13, 8:45-9:45 a.m., Mrs. Lou Carmack will discuss Advanced Academic Programs (formerly Gifted/Talented) and the parent referral process. On

Wednesday, December 3, 8:45-9:45 a.m., Mrs. Michelle Visconti, math specialist, will explain how teachers develop math skills. Family Literacy Night on Veterans Day, November 11, 7 p.m., will provide lots of ideas to promote reading and writing.
