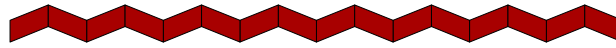




WEATHER RADIOS

- **RADIO SHACK 7-Channel Digital**
- 9-volt battery back-up power
- Alarm sounds whenever the NWS issues a broadcast.
- Receives all messages issued by the Washington/Baltimore Weather Center



- **MIDLAND Model 74-200**
- 9-volt battery back-up power
- Alarm sounds whenever the NWS issues a broadcast.
- S.A.M.E. technology allows user to have the radio receive messages specific to one or more counties.
- LED screen and alert lights indicate type of message.



- **MIDLAND Model WR-100**
- AA battery (3 needed) back-up power
- Alarm sounds whenever the NWS issues a broadcast.
- S.A.M.E. technology allows user to have the radio receive messages specific to one or more counties.
- LED screen and alert lights indicate type of message.
