

## Attention Rising 2nd Graders!

Check out what is expected of you as you enter 2nd grade.

*Mandated by FCPS*

You are able to:

- Use manuscript letters to communicate a message to others.
- Distinguish between fiction/non-fiction books
- Correct number and letter formation
- Skip count by 2's, 5's, and 10's to 100
- Mentally compute addition facts to 10 and corresponding subtraction facts (fact families  $3 + 2 = 5$ ,  $5 - 2 = 3$ ).

*Highly Recommended by Second Grade Teachers*

You are able to:

- Write on lined paper
- Read 10 – 15 minutes independently
- Read a variety of fiction/non-fiction books
- Retell basic story elements (characters, setting, events – beginning, middle, end)
  
- Basic math facts (adding to sum of 10 and subtracting from 10)

*What can you do this summer to review for 2nd Grade?*

- Read daily!
- Write simple sentences (use capitalization and punctuation correctly)
- Write on lined paper
- Practice your math facts to 10
- Participate in the summer reading program at the Kingstowne Library.
