1.03 **Full-Day Kindergarten** (Exhibit A)

- BOS supported the goal of full day kindergarten, but the next budget cycle would not be able to accommodate any new initiatives;
- School Board may need to reprioritize within the current resources in order to accomplish the proposed full day kindergarten schedule or spread the schedule out over more years; and
- Comment that FCPS was committed to make the pre-kindergarten/kindergarten link successful in Fairfax County.
