- Superintendent to develop a survey for parents to take to help the Board better understand Kiss N' Ride usage.

##### FairfaxCorp: Collaboration with the Park Authority to devise a program that is available to our students to support the range of park responsibilities and meets our "responsibility to the community" goal (Niedzielski-Eichner)

- Consensus of the Board that additional information about current interactions and arrangements between the Park Authority and the school system were needed by the Board before a discussion between the Park Authority and the School Board would take place.
