Issues Discussed:

(Exhibit A)

- Two new FCPS elementary schools would open in September 2009, with traditional SACC programs; interested schools in the Lee District would be identified to pilot cost-efficient SACC programs that maximized school/county cooperation and would open in September 2010;
- recognition that building services differ where children were present but agreement to develop common standards for services in non-school buildings and begin to seek efficiencies in recycling, trash pick-up, landscaping, snow removal;
- food service was a strong area for collaboration and first steps would begin with vending services;
- warehouse functioning already enjoyed a strong school/county collaboration and staff would look into the possibility of joint, single management;
- continued discussion on efficiencies in the transportation systems and agreement that school and county staff needed to work collaboratively to reduce traffic congestion at the schools;
- legal services would be an additional efficiency to consider.
