121.01 Call to Order and Announcements

DISCUSSION

121.02 Boundaries (Annandale High School and Fort Belvoir Elementary School) (Exhibit A)

- Staff reported that questions had been received from Annandale High School (AHS) community, but none from Fort Belvoir Elementary School constituents; all questions and answers were posted to frequently asked questions on the Facilities website and linked to the School Board website;
- question whether a modular unit could be placed at AHS in lieu of trailers; staff responded that adding a modular would exceed the floor area ratio, would require a zoning exception from the county, would require more site planning and permitting, and would not solve the current capacity issue;
- question whether the neighborhood community center could be moved off AHS campus to allow additional space for trailers; staff responded they would review the memorandum of understanding, but did not think another option existed;
- request that staff provide detailed information for potential grandfathering and early assignment options as well as transportation requirements for students impacted by the boundary adjustment; and
- requested that staff add a frequently asked question to the website which would address FCPS' bonding authority to use excess bond funds for a modular at AHS.
