## PSAT COST:

- 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students pay \$17.00 (10<sup>th</sup> graders funded through FCPS) for personalized score reports. It is highly recommended that all students receive this valuable score report. Items included in the score report:

  - For Juniors – Opportunity to enter the 2013 competition for National Merit Scholarship Program recognition and scholarships

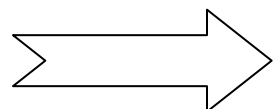

- Fee waivers are available for Juniors on free and reduced lunch; see your counselor for details and information.
- Turn in **checks payable to “WSHS”** at Spartan Spree August 30, Parent Information Nights (Juniors – September 13 & Freshmen September 27) or Back to School Night September 20; when paying by check, **please place your child’s full name and grade level on the memo line of the check.**
- Because FCPS is paying for tenth grade PSAT Score Reports, 10<sup>th</sup> graders do not need to register. They will automatically be signed up for the test.
- **FREE PSAT MINI-PREP SESSION OPEN TO ALL STUDENTS GRADES 9-11:** Wednesday, **October 5, 2:30 PM to 3:30 PM** in the Cafeteria. Before attending the session, students are asked to complete their practice test **LOCATED IN THE “Official Student Guide to the PSAT/NMSQT”** (distributed to all students in grades 9–11 through their Spartan Spree Packet). Test day tips and strategies will be discussed and reviewed.

# **Saturday SAT Test Prep Program**

## **Open to 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Graders Only**

### **Open to the first 250 students**

This test prep program will be for students who have **\*\*NOT** taken the WSHS Test Prep Program previously.

Students planning to participate in the Saturday Test Prep Program must bring a **\$50.00 check payable to WSHS** to Spartan Spree (payment can be made at the PSAT table – please pay with a separate check from PSAT payment) or to Ms. O’Brien in the Student Services Office (put student’s name and grade level in memo line). Class will close at 250 students. All Students in the program will be issued an online course code that will be available for use for one year.
