



# School Improvement Plan

## W. T. Woodson High School

### 2011-2012

#### Academics

##### SMART Goal 1

The pass rate of students on summative assessments (e.g. eCart, SOLs) will be 90% in every subgroup, in every subject (except English, which will be 91%) by the end of the school year.

##### SMART Goal 2

By identifying students who have the potential to be successful in AP courses, enrollment in AP courses for the 2012-2013 school year will increase by 4%.

##### SMART Goal 3

The pass advanced rate on Spring 2012 SOL exams will increase by 5%. For example, a course with a pass advanced rate of 40% in 2011 should increase to 45% in 2012.

#### Essential Life Skills

##### SMART Goal 1

Students will be educated on personal and academic integrity, resulting in a 5% reduction of honor code violations by the end of the school year (note that honor code *violations* differ from honor code *referrals*)

##### SMART Goal 2

Students and teachers will be educated in developing mutual trust and respect in the classroom and school community, as measured by a decrease of 5% in discipline violations in the areas of defiance and insubordination by the end of the school year (note that discipline *violations* differ from discipline *referrals*)

##### SMART Goal 1

By Graduation 2012, W.T. Woodson will have 25 students earning the State Civic Seal

##### SMART Goal 2

By Graduation 2012, W.T. Woodson will have 170 students graduating with Service Learning Cords
