About the Renaming Process

- A School Board authority
- Governed by <u>Policy 8170.7- Naming School Facilities</u> and <u>Regulation 8170.8</u>
- Per Policy 8170, The School Board may "consider a change in the name of an existing school or facility to ensure an inclusive, respectful learning environment as outlined in our adopted One Fairfax Policy or when the Board deems it appropriate..."

Renaming Process - Phase 1

- September 12 October 12
- Purpose: Determine whether or not to rename the school, explore the option of Dr. Carter G. Woodson as a new name.
- Community Engagement:
 - Online Feedback Form (September 15 October 12, 12:00 p.m.) 1,415 responses
 - Community Meeting (October 4) Approximately 60 attendees
 - Public Hearing (October 10) 8 speakers
- School Board Action October 12 Proceed with name change process

School Board voted to proceed with the renaming process for W.T. Woodson HS
