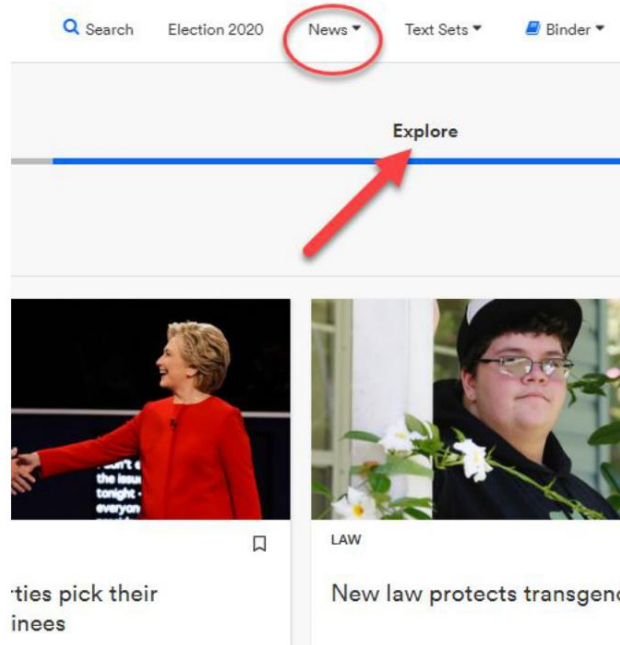
<p>Access NewsELA website. Click “Sign In.”</p>

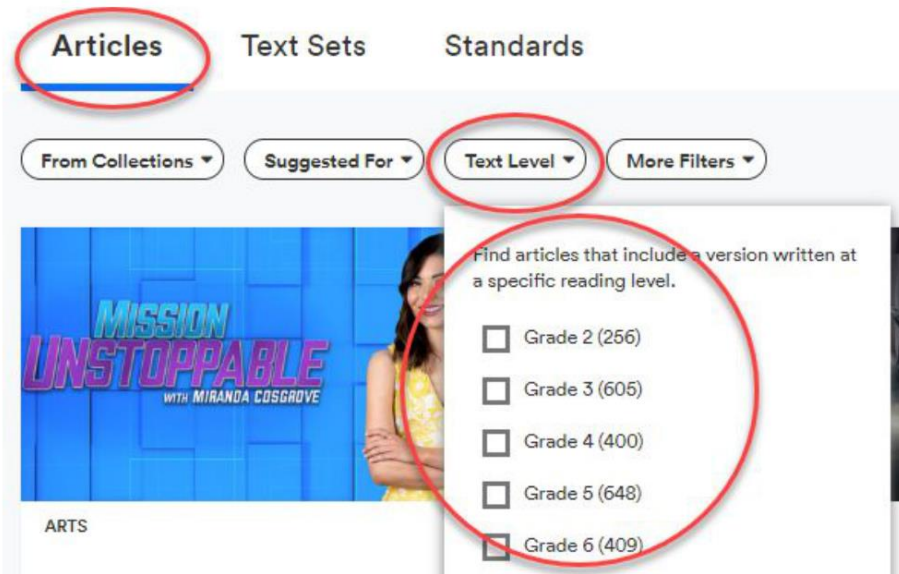
HOW TO USE NewsELA: A GUIDING DOCUMENT FOR PARENTS

Utilize the “News” tab and the “Explore” section for accessible texts.




Access “Articles” to explore preferred text to read.

Select “Text Level” to filter options and find an article that includes versions written at a specific reading level.

Once an article is selected, the "MAX" drop down can be used to select a different Lexile level. The lower the Lexile level, the less complex the text will be for lower level readers.
