Reading (Decoding)

Decoding is the ability to apply knowledge of letter-sound relationships to correctly say written words.

- Letter-sound relationship examples: c sounds like /k/ like in 'cat'
- Including letter patterns: "tion" at the end of words, sounds like "shun" like in 'action'

Understanding these relationships gives children the ability to recognize familiar words quickly and to figure out words they haven't seen before.
