Official results are provided below for multiple choice Virginia Alternate Assessment Program (VAAP) tests your student took this past school year. Your student's scaled score and performance level are listed for each VAAP test.

Scaled scores are reported on a scale of 625-880. A student who receives a scaled score of 740 or above is considered proficient. If a student attains a scaled score of 780 or higher, they are considered to have performed at an advanced level on the test. An overall scaled score between 625 and 739 indicates the student did not meet proficiency on the test. An entry of "NS" means no score is available. An explanation of why the student did not receive a score is provided in the performance level descriptor box.

Descriptors explain the knowledge and skills that a student demonstrated for the performance level.
