

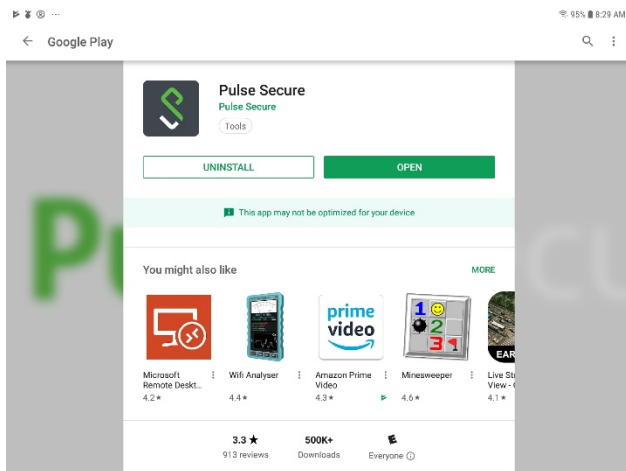

### Setting up Pulse Secure SSL VPN client on an Android Device

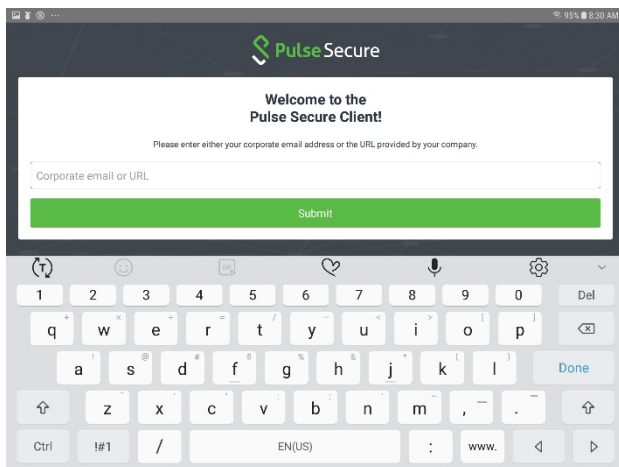
To connect to the SSL VPN on your Android device, you must first download and install the Pulse Secure SSL VPN client from the Google Play Store. The Pulse Secure application needs to be downloaded and installed only one time. Once you have installed that application, configure it as follows.

Install the software and tap **Open**.

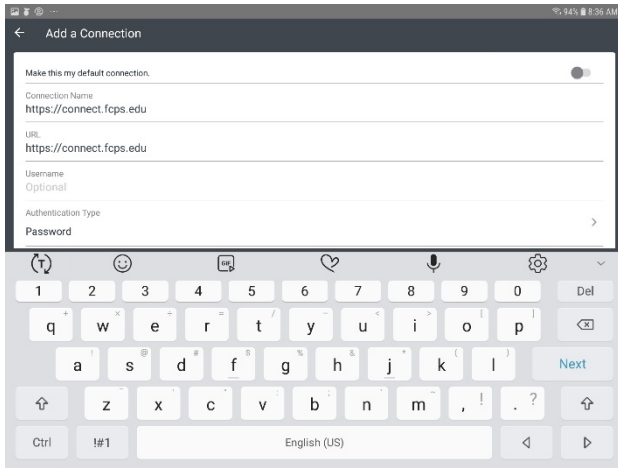


The Pulse Secure VPN Client will need access to your files. Please click on the accept tab during installation.

Open the Pulse Secure VPN Client. When asked to enter email or **URL**, enter the [connect.fcps.edu](https://connect.fcps.edu) URL.



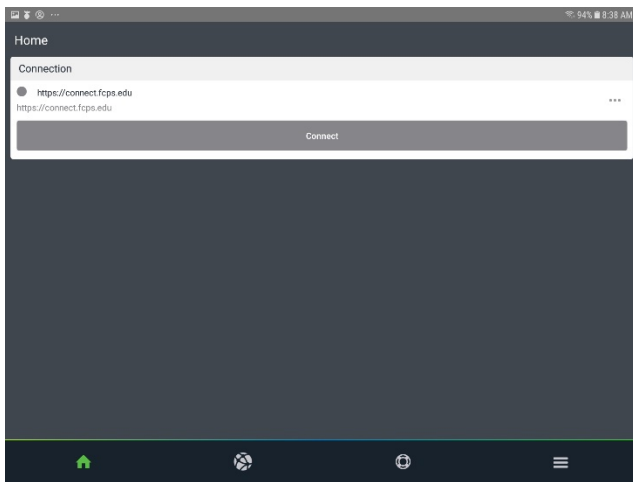
Select the slide to “Make this my default connection”.



Enter FCPS **username** on the appropriate line.

Select **Add** at the bottom of the page.

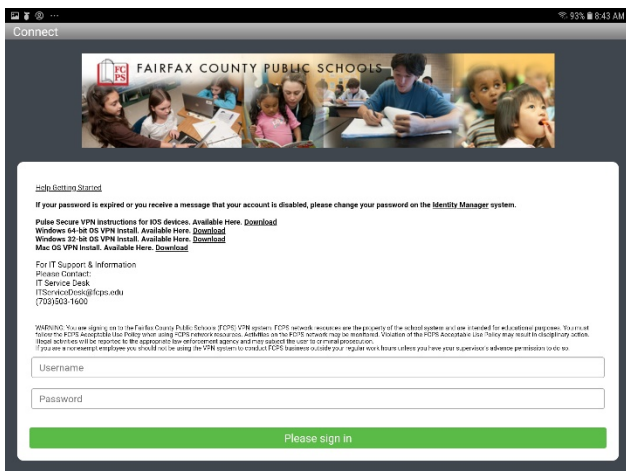
Tap **Connect** on the next page.



There will be a Security warning.

Tap **Accept** button.

Enter your FCPS **username** and **password**. Tap **Please Sign In**.



You will then be connected via FCPS Pulse Secure VPN. You can then close the **Disconnect** page and begin surfing or performing other work securely.

When done, you can open Pulse Secure again and the **Disconnect** page will display and you can tap Disconnect to end your FCPS VPN session.
