



REQUEST TO TRANSFER UNUSED SICK LEAVE FROM FAIRFAX COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

To Human Resources or Payroll Manager:

The employee listed below was previously employed by Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) and has notified us that he or she is currently employed by your school division. Employees previously employed with FCPS may transfer any or all accumulated sick leave to their new school division.

To Be Completed By Employee:

If you are a vested member of the ERFC plan or FCERS, you have until your termination/retirement date to complete this form and return it to Payroll Management to have any portion of your sick leave balance transferred to the Fairfax County government or another school division. Your sick leave balance, as of your termination date less any transferred amount, will be converted to retirement credit with FCPS and cannot be later transferred.

All other employees have up to one year from termination/retirement date to complete this form and return it to Payroll Management to have any portion of their sick leave balance transferred to the Fairfax County government or another school division.
