VDOE State Performance Plan (SPP)

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) requires each state to develop a state performance plan (SPP) that evaluates the state's efforts to implement the requirements and purposes of the IDEA and describes how the state will improve its implementation.

- The SPP includes how States will improve educational outcomes or results for students with disabilities on 17 components or **Indicators**.
- The SPP must be updated every six years.
- It is time for Virginia to update the SPP that will cover FFY 2020 - 2025 (Federal Fiscal Year).

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- Improvement is measured based on Indicator "targets" that States set.
- Virginia must set new targets, as it updates the Plan.
- The ACSD, as a stakeholder, will assist in defining "success" in Virginia, as you recommend new targets for nine of the 17 Indicators.
- The 9 Indicators are: 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 14, and 17.
- Your participant input regarding target-setting will be captured via a survey in which you are strongly encouraged to participate.
