1. Meeting called to order at 7:03 pm by Carrie Reynolds.
2. Twenty-one voting members present.
3. Introductions of committee members.
4. Approval of September meeting minutes.
5. Presentation of Fairfax County Youth Survey results from school year 2021-2022. Bethany A. Demers, M.A, C.A.S., Educational Specialist, Mental Wellness with Fairfax County Public Schools provided an overview of the survey and data obtained and discussed the importance of protective factors to reducing risk behaviors among youth.
6. Committee began review and discussion of proposed objectives related to consent for grades K-6. Using committee feedback from the September meeting, Instructional Services staff prepared the proposed objectives for the committee to consider. Following discussion of all objectives in grades K-6, the committee will consider approval as one motion.

The committee reviewed kindergarten and grade one during the meeting and provided recommended revisions.

Motion: To change the proposed language in the kindergarten from, "...family members, neighbors, strangers, and others" to "people both inside and outside the family."
