- Writers match their choice of genre and form with the purpose of their writing.
- Writers recognize the impact their piece has on the audience.
- 1. Think of a person or group of people you want to write to. (i.e. my parents, my class, last year's teacher)
- 2. Ask yourself, "What kind of writing would they want to read?" or "What do I want to say to them?" (e.g., write a letter, make a list, tell a story, etc.)
- 3. Try a flash draft of your piece in your writer's notebook, or on paper.
- 4. Think about what your writing piece will look like when finished (special paper, typed, written on lined paper, etc.)
- 5. Use everything you know about good writing to complete your writing piece.
