AUTO TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENT

This is to advise you of the personal protective requirements for your student to participate in the automotive technology portion of Tech Adventure Camp.

- Additional safety gear and clothing will be provided for students to use when needed.
- **Closed toe shoes** are required to work in the automotive laboratories.
- Hair ties or a hat is needed for any camper with long hair.
- **Safety glasses** will be provided and must be worn by each camper during **all** automotive activities in the automotive laboratories.
- Your child will receive instructions on safety policies and procedures prior to each activity. It is important for all campers to understand the rules and procedures that are to be followed in the automotive laboratory. He/She must understand that **Virginia law requires the use of safety glasses and proper clothing be worn in the shop area at all times!** We appreciate your help in reinforcing these important safety procedures with your son/daughter.
- Please be advised that we will be using Oxygen/Acetylene torches and welders as part of the program this year. These areas will have direct supervision and specific safety gear.

Please return this signed form on the first day of camp. Campers without a signed automotive technology agreement on file will not be able to participate in automotive laboratory activities.

AUTOTECH SAFETY RULES

1. ALWAYS WEAR EYE PROTECTION IN THE SHOP. VA STATE LAW
2. TAKE CARE OF LOOSE CLOTHING
 - TUCK IN SHIRT TAILS
 - LONG SLEEVES ROLLED UP
 - JACKETS OFF
 - MUST WEAR APPROPRIATE CLOSED TOE SHOES
3. REMOVE ANY LOOSE JEWELRY
4. TIE BACK LONG HAIR. WEAR A HAT IF NECESSARY
5. OBTAIN TEACHER APPROVAL BEFORE USING **ANY** EQUIPMENT
6. DO **NOT** USE ANY EQUIPMENT UNLESS YOU KNOW HOW IT WORKS. ASK YOUR INSTRUCTOR FOR HELP IF YOU ARE UNSURE
7. IF ANYTHING BREAKS OR SEEMS STRANGE, NOTIFY YOUR INSTRUCTOR
8. TURN OFF **ALL** EQUIPMENT IF THE TEACHER LEAVES THE SHOP
9. REPORT **ALL** INJURIES TO YOUR TEACHER IMMEDIATELY
10. REMEMBER THE *ABC'S* OF SAFETY, **ALWAYS BE CAREFUL**
11. ABSOLUTELY NO FOOLING AROUND
12. BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS
