This letter provides information about your student's growth on state assessments so you can join us in celebrating their learning. Earlier this summer, we shared an official Standards of Learning (SOL) or Virginia Alternate Assessment program (VAAP) score report. That report showed the overall test scaled score and performance level for each of your student's spring SOL or VAAP tests.
Even though your student did not earn a proficient score for reading and/or mathematics on their spring test, their performance improved from previous state tests. This means your student is closer to meeting grade level standards. Virginia recognizes this growth when measuring school success for the Standards of Accreditation (SOA).
