FCPS School Board Policy 3290 allows for parents or caregivers to determine whether the use of an instructional material with sexually explicit content is appropriate for their child. Parents or caregivers shall communicate their request for an alternative instructional material to the teacher using Form IS-710, *Request for Alternative Instructional Material*. Upon a parent, caregiver, or student's request, schools shall provide, in a manner that is not punitive, alternative instructional materials for the student that do not include sexually explicit content. Parents or caregivers may change their decision with respect to the use of alternative instructional materials by providing notice to the school.
