- 1. Students who request a transfer for the Global STEM Challenges Program must enter the program in grade 9 and commit to the program for grades 9, 10, and 11:
 - Each student is expected to pursue the three designated courses for the Global STEM Challenges Program in grades 9, 10, 11.
 - Pursuing the full International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma is not a requirement for the global STEM Challenges Program. However, if your student is planning on completing the full IB Diploma, he or she must meet with the IB Diploma Coordinator to develop a four-year academic plan.
- 2. Students who request a transfer for the Global STEM Challenges Program must be on track to complete a minimum of Algebra 1 successfully by the end of 8th grade.
- 3. There are a limited number of available seats for the program, applications will be considered on a space available basis and based on date of receipt.
- 4. Parents and students are encouraged to attend a Global STEM Challenges information session hosted by the school or the division.
- 5. Students are expected to maintain appropriate behavior, attend school regularly and demonstrate academic progress.
- 6. A student who does not fulfill the aforementioned expectations will be required to return to his or her base school.
- 7. A student transfer renewal application must be submitted annually for continued student transfer consideration.
- 8. Decisions regarding Global STEM transfer requests will be made after course selection is complete for base school students. Decisions will be sent to families beginning in mid-March.
