Instructions for QuideI[™] QuickVue At-Home OTC COVID-19 Test

This test has been authorized by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) under an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for nonprescription home use with self-collected direct anterior nasal (nares) swab samples from individuals aged 14 years or older. This test is also authorized for non-prescription home use with adult-collected anterior nasal swab samples from individuals aged 2 years or older.

Before testing, wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer. Make sure your hands are completely dry.

• Step 1: Locate test kit materials

- Tubes (liquid is inside tube)
- Tube Holder
- o Swabs
- o Test Strips

• Step 2: Place tube in the tube holder

- Remove cap from one tube
- Place the tube in the tube holder

• Step 3: Swab the nostrils

- Remove the swab from the swab wrapper (do not touch the head of the swab)
- Gently insert the swab 1/2 to 3/4 of an inch into the nostril
- Firmly rub the swab in a circular motion around the inside wall of a nostril at least 4 times.
- o Repeat in the other nostril using the same swab

• Step 4: Place swab in the tube

- o Immediately place the swab into the liquid inside the tube (make sure it is touching the bottom of the tube)
- Stir the swab 3 to 4 times
- Leave the swab in the solution for **ONE MINUTE**
- Step 5: Remove swab from the tube
 - After one minute, remove the swab from the tube by rubbing the swab head against the inside wall of the tube to squeeze out as much liquid as possible
 - \circ Dispose of swab in the trash
- Step 6: Open the test strip
 - Open the test strip pouch carefully at the slit and hold the test strip as indicated
- Step 7: Place the test strip in the tube
 - Place the test strip into the tube with the arrows on the strip pointing down
 - o Leave the strip in the tube for a **FULL TEN MINUTES** and do not handle or remove test strip
- Step 8: Remove test strip from the tube
 - At 10 minutes, remove the test strip from the tube
 - o Lay the test strip is on a flat surface

<u>A positive test</u> result must show both <u>a blue line and a pink line</u>. The blue line is the control line the pink line is the test line.

A negative test result will show a blue line but NO pink line.

<u>An **invalid test**</u> result will show either **no line or only a pink line**. The test should be repeated starting at the beginning using a new tube, new swab, and new test strip.

Testing materials can be thrown away in the trash. Wash hands or use hand sanitizer after completing steps.
